### Content

- Other procedures include: Argon-helium cryoablation and radiofrequency ablation of hepatocellular carcinoma, hyperthermic intraperitoneal chemotherapy (HIPEC), bariatric surgery which including gastric bypass surgery for weight loss, gastrointestinal surgery for severe obesity, weight loss surgery, LAP-BAND, and treatment for metabolic syndrome and obesity.
