3	REGULATIONS REGARDING STUDENTS LEAVE FOR ABSENCE OR WITHDRAWAL FROM THEIR STUDIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● When applying for deferral or abandons, the university must <b>IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY</b> the <u>Bureau of Consular Affairs of the Ministry of the Foreign Affairs</u> and <u>the service center(s) of the National Immigration Agency of the Ministry of the Interior</u> where their educational institution is located. <b>The National Immigration Agency will then revoke the student's Alien Resident Certificate, and the student must leave Taiwan within 10 days.</b> (Article 24 of the <a href="#">Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan</a>; and Article 31 and Article 36 of the <a href="#">Immigration Act</a>.)</li> <li>● Those who is resume studies after leave of absence must reapply for a <b>resident visa</b>, and for an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) <b>WITHIN 15 DAYS</b> after arrival. 5	REGULATIONS REGARDING WORKING IN TAIWAN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>MUST</b> apply for a work permit to work in Taiwan and are <b>NOT</b> permitted to work more than <b>20 hours per week</b>, except for winter and summer vacations. (Article 43 and Article 50 of the <a href="#">Employment Service Act</a>.)</li> <li>● Students who work without a valid work permit will be fined an amount of <b>at least NTD 30,000 and at most NTD 150,000</b>, and <b><u>will be IMMEDIATELY ORDERED TO DEPART FROM TAIWAN</u></b> and banned from further engaging in <b><u>work in Taiwan</u></b>. Those who fail to depart as ordered by the competent authority, the national entry and exit administrative authority may enforce their departure and may hold the person in detention prior to deportation. (Paragraphs 1, 3 and 4 of Article 68 of the <a href="#">Employment Service Act</a>.)</li> <li>● Students who works in Taiwan illegally will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the regulations of the university governing student awards and penalties and depending on the circumstances of the case.     <a href="#">Employment Service Act</a></li> </ul>
