# "COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION IN PUBLIC HEALTH DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC ERA"

# **SUMMARY**

In the context of internationalization and supporting the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), the Faculty of Public Health, Universitas Diponegoro (FPH UNDIP) strengthens international cooperation and networking through the Summer Course Program. The Summer Course Program in 2022 is the fourth program offered to international students (undergraduate/post-gradute/doctoral programs) and lecturers at various universities as well as researchers and practitioners in the health sector affiliated to overseas institution. This year, the topic raised is "Community Participation in Public Health during Covid-19 Pandemic Era" considering that during the current pandemic there are several elements of strengthening community participation related to preventing the transmission of Covid-19. Summer Course Program is held to integrate lecture activities and field practice so that participants can gain scientific insight into the health sector and various good practices and cultures gained through this activity. This Summer Course Program is carried out online due to considerations during the Covid-19 pandemic, through Zoom Meetings and Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCS) on  $13^{th} - 23^{rd}$  July 2022. With this program, it is hoped that it will open up opportunities for collaboration between FPH UNDIP and universities abroad both in terms of academics, student affairs, and research.

#### BACKGROUND

Globalization as an economic, political, and social force has pushed higher education in the 21st century toward greater international engagement. Globalization has also given rise to demands for higher education institutions to increase competitiveness towards a World-class University through the internationalization process. Although internationalization and globalization can be viewed differently, they are dynamically two interrelated concepts. Globalization is understood as a catalyst while internationalization related to higher education include a) Knowledge Society, b) Information and Communication Technologies (ICTS), c) Market Economy, d) Trade Liberalization, and e) Governance. These elements have a dual position, namely being both causes and causes related to their implications for the education sector, especially the internationalization of higher education.

According to Foskett in 2010, there were three main reasons for a university to internationalize. The first reason is that the implementation of internationalization is considered capable of developing human resources to face competition in the global market. This is the main reason universities carry out internationalization in order to prepare their graduates to have an international dimension in entering the job market. Internationalization also encourages research activities as a form of contribution in solving global problems. It is based on the premise that global issues require internationalization can also play an educative role in promoting international values, which is based on the premise that universities must prepare graduates to become global citizens and understand cultural differences.

A number of significant environmental changes in shaping responses and actions related to internationalization programs such as curriculum internationalization in learning, mobility of students, lecturers, and staff, implementation of cross-border education programs, foreign language studies, research collaborations, and other internationalization programs as needed and college reasons. The objective of the Faculty of Public Health UNDIP to carry out internationalization is in line with the Strategic Plan and Vision of UNDIP and in line with the internationalization policy in Indonesia as stated in the Long Term Strategy for Higher Education. Therefore, Faculty of Public Health UNDIP as a university that is part of the global community is expected to play an active role in realizing national education plans and ideals.

In order to achieve these goals, Faculty of Public Health UNDIP will provide facilitation to strengthen international cooperation and networking through the Summer Course Program. This summer course program is offered to foreign students at health institutions abroad. The Summer Course Program is held to integrate lecture activities and field practice so that participants can gain scientific insight into the health sector and various good practices and cultures gained through this activity. Furthermore, through the Summer Course Program, it is hoped that Faculty of Public Health UNDIP will open opportunities for collaboration with universities abroad, both in terms of academics, student affairs, and research.





# **OBJECTIVE**

- 1. Inviting international students, graduate students, lecturers, researchers, and health practitioners to learn and develop knowledge of Community Participation in Public Health during Covid-19 Pandemic Era at Faculty of Public Health UNDIP
- 2. Cultivating a culture of scientific cooperation in a multicultural atmosphere for Faculty of Public Health UNDIP Academic Community
- 3. Initiating and promoting the Faculty of Public Health UNDIP internationalization program
- 4. Increasing the number of international students and academics at Faculty of Public Health UNDIP

#### TARGET

The targets of the Summer Course Program are international students (undergraduate/postgradute/doctoral programs) and lecturers at various universities in the world besides Indonesia, as well as researchers and health practitioners affiliated to overseas institution.
