

Tuition and Miscellaneous Fee Refund Standards for Taipei Medical University

Student suspension/withdrawal time	Proportion of tuition/ miscellaneous fees refunded	Remarks
1. Student applies for suspension/withdrawal on or before the registration date	No payment required; full refund where already paid	
2. Student applies for suspension/withdrawal from (including that day) day following registration date, to day before the first day of a new semester	Two-thirds of tuition fees, and all miscellaneous fees, shall be refunded.	
3. Student applies for suspension/withdrawal on or after the first day of a new semester, and where not more than one-third of the semester has elapsed	Two-thirds of tuition and miscellaneous fees shall be refunded.	
4. Student applies for suspension/withdrawal after the first day of a new semester (including that day) and more than one-third of the semester but less than two-thirds of the semester has elapsed	One-third of tuition and miscellaneous fees shall be refunded.	
5. Student applies for suspension/withdrawal when more than two-thirds of the semester after has elapsed since the first day of a new semester (including that day)	Tuition and miscellaneous fees already paid shall not be refunded.	
<p>Remark:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The calculation of the above-mentioned registration dates, first day of a new semester, and semesters shall be determined by the officially-announced calendar of Taipei Medical University; if the university does not specify a registration date, the registration date shall be the deadline for payment of registration fees. For a student who withdraws on their own or applies for suspension, the time of their suspension/withdrawal shall be calculated based on the date when the student (or parent) formally submits the application for suspension/withdrawal to the Office of Academic Affairs. If the student was ordered to withdraw, the time of withdrawal shall be calculated based on the date when the university's notice of withdrawal was delivered. However, if the student remains in the university due to a withdrawal appeal, the actual date of leaving the university shall be used as the base date for calculation. A student who is suspended or withdraws from the university shall complete the procedures for leaving the university within the period specified by the university. If there is a delay in procedures due to factors attributable to the student, the actual date of leaving university shall be used as the base date for calculation. The university is not allowed to pre-collect any fees in advance of the semester start date specified in the university calendar. All information is available in both Chinese and English. In case of discrepancies between the two versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.
